Solids: Sorting and Classifying

Solids: Three dimensional shape that has the following attributes:

- 1. Faces single flat surface of a solid, may be square or rectangular or any polygon.
- 2. Edges line segments between two faces, when they meet.
- 3. Vertices a corner point where the edges of the solid figures meet. (plural is vertices)




