Word Association

Here's a list of 40 words that children can use to brainstorm related words, write synonyms and antonyms, word families, and related terms.

For each of these words, children can explore various aspects of language:

Synonyms: Similar words (e.g., happy - joyful, glad)

Antonyms: Opposite words (e.g., big - small, fast - slow)

Word Families: Related forms (e.g., run - runner, running)

Related Terms: Concepts associated with the word (e.g., tree - leaves, branches)

This activity encourages creativity, expands vocabulary, and helps children understand how words are interconnected in language.
