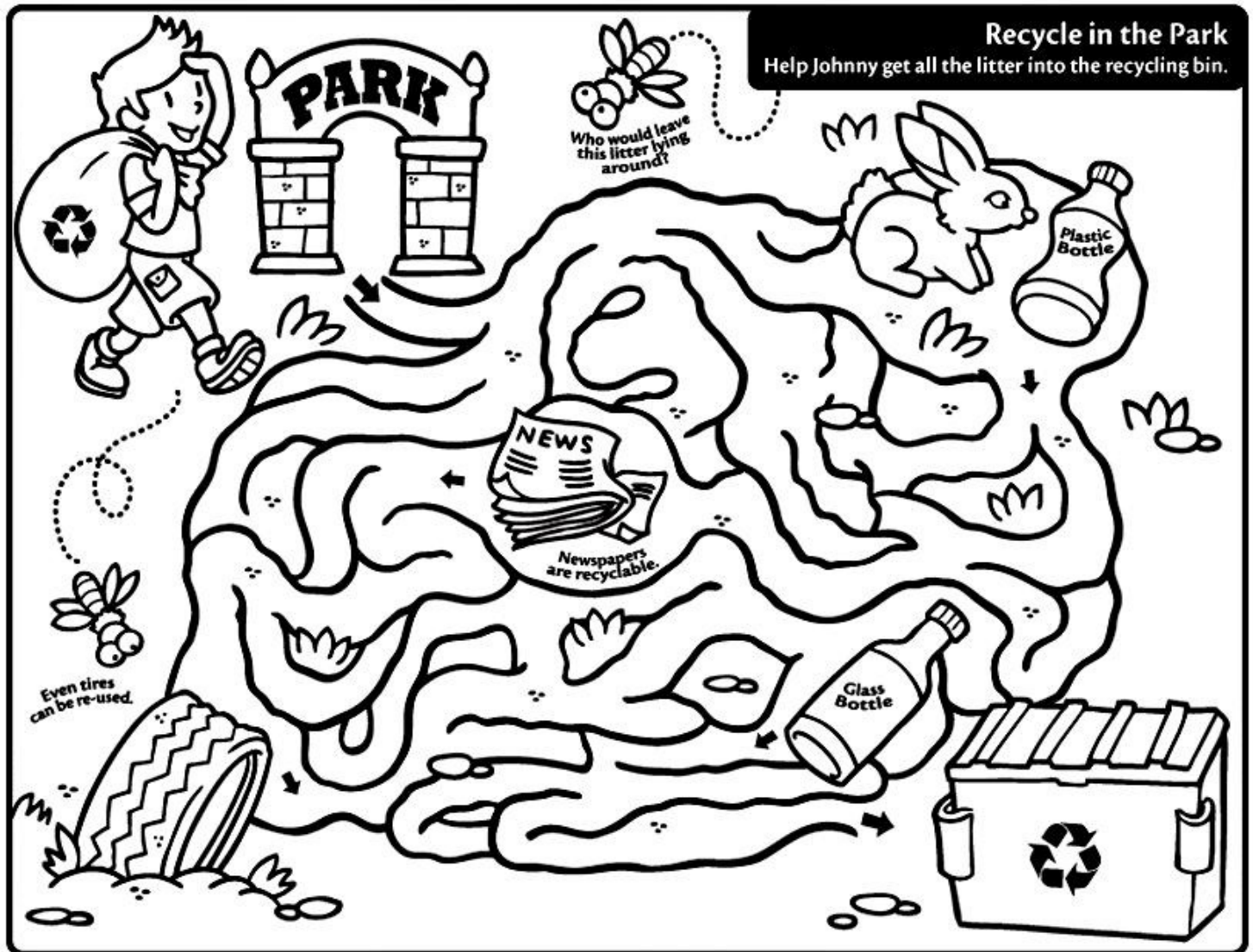


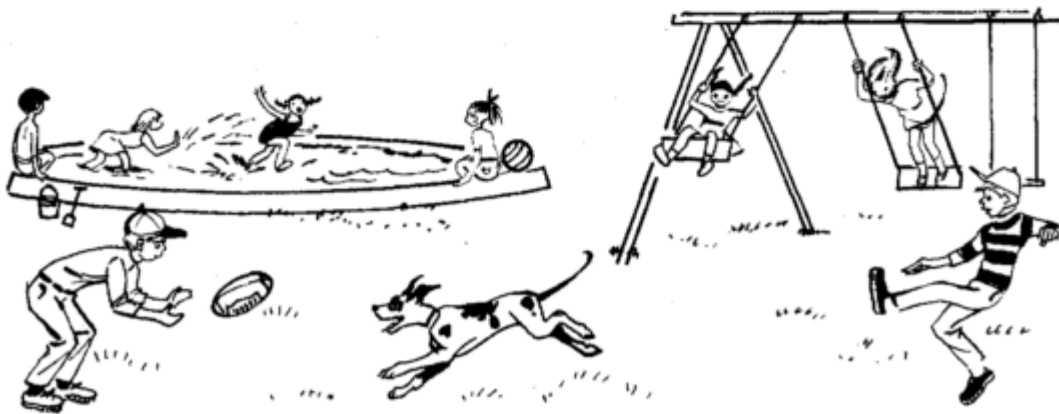
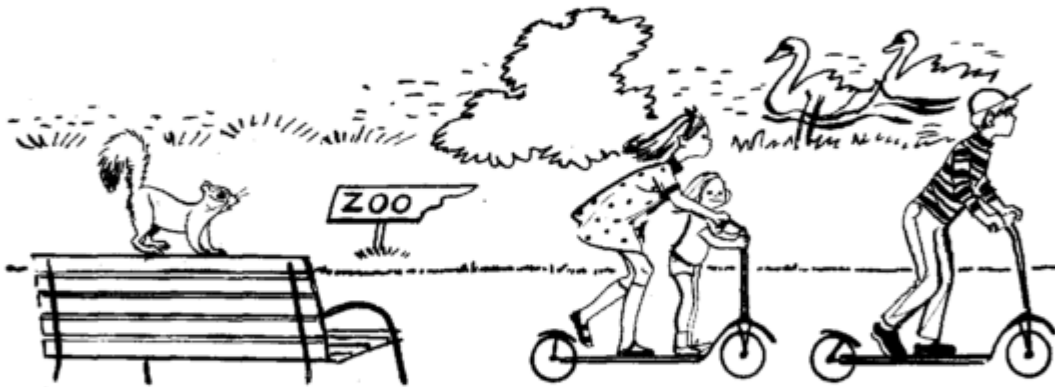
LITTER - ACTIVITIES AND WORKSHEETS

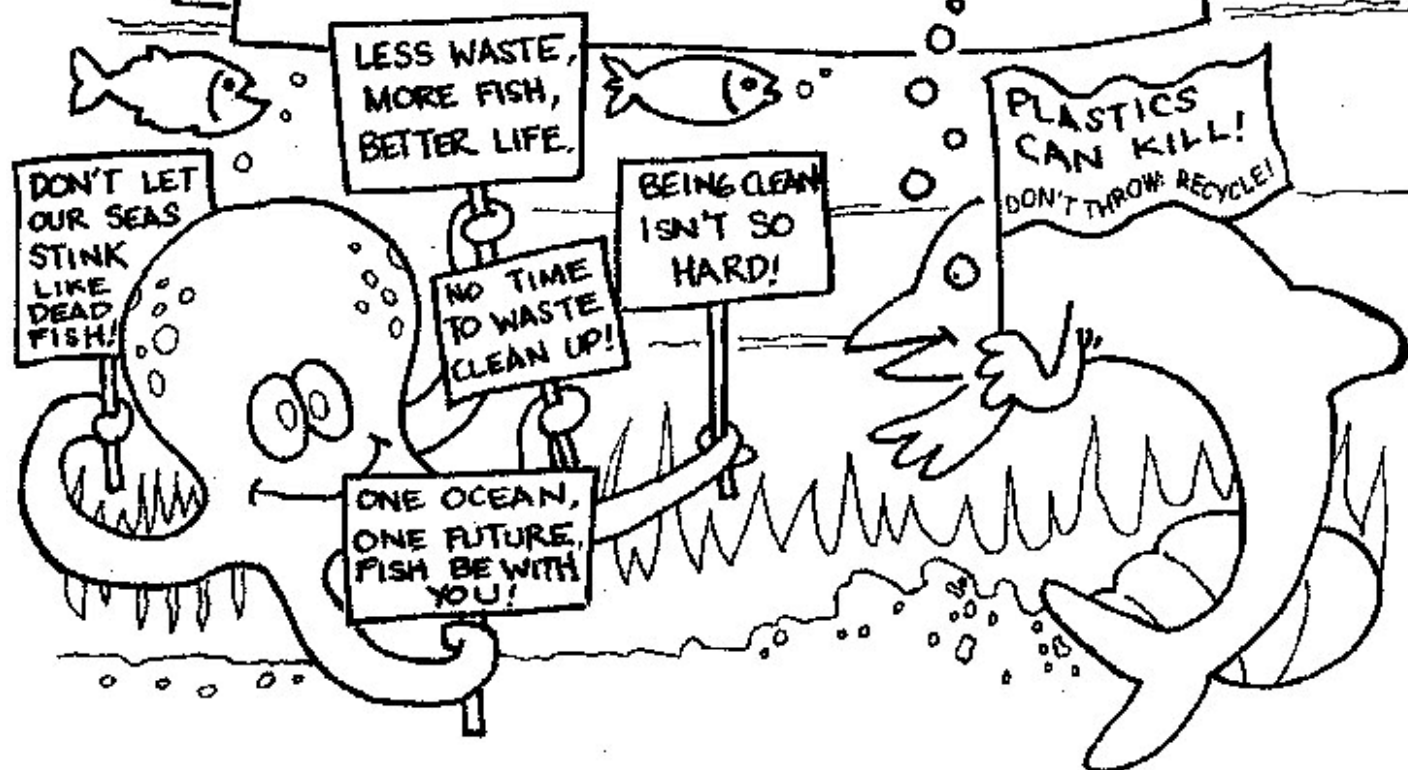


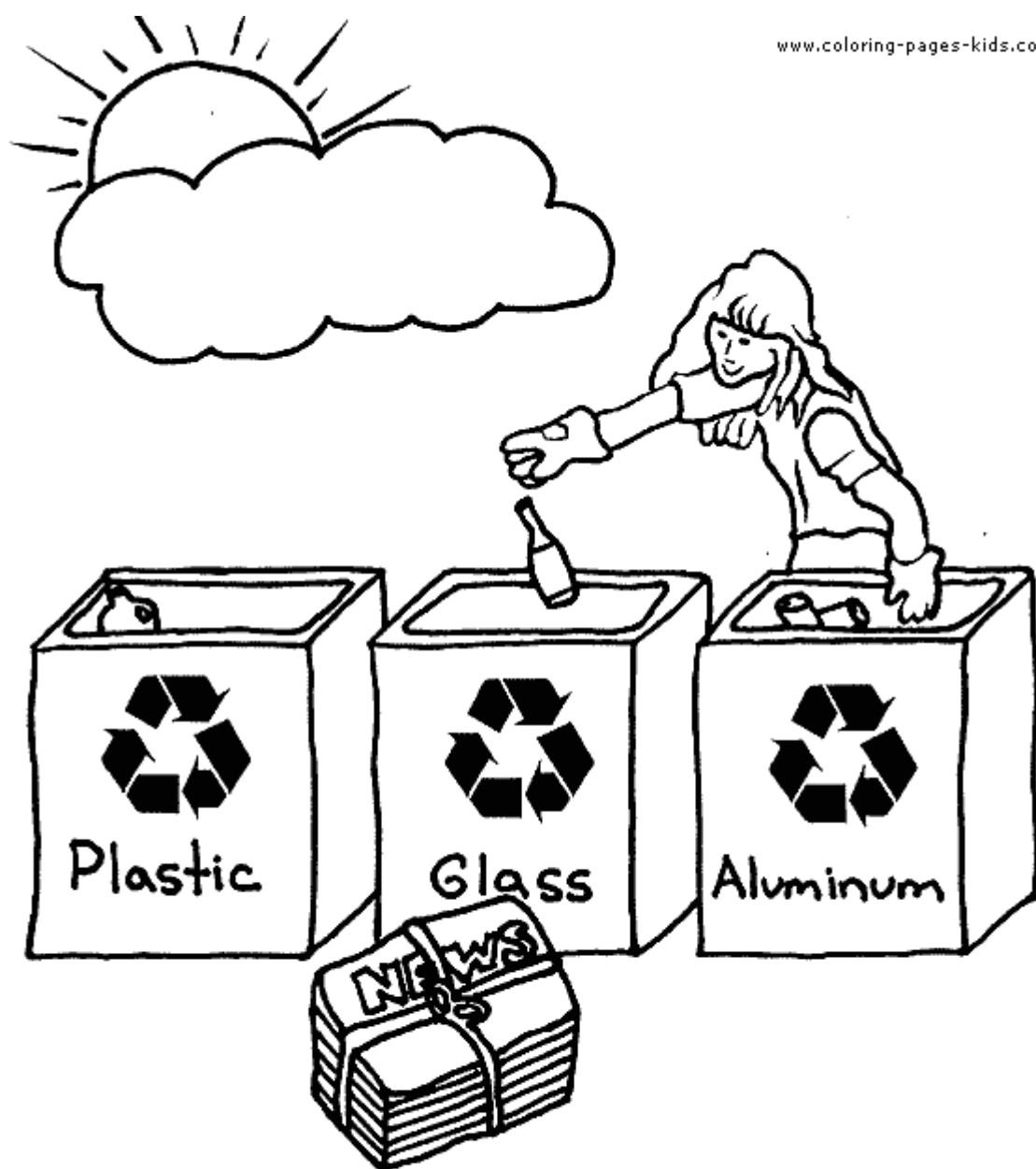
