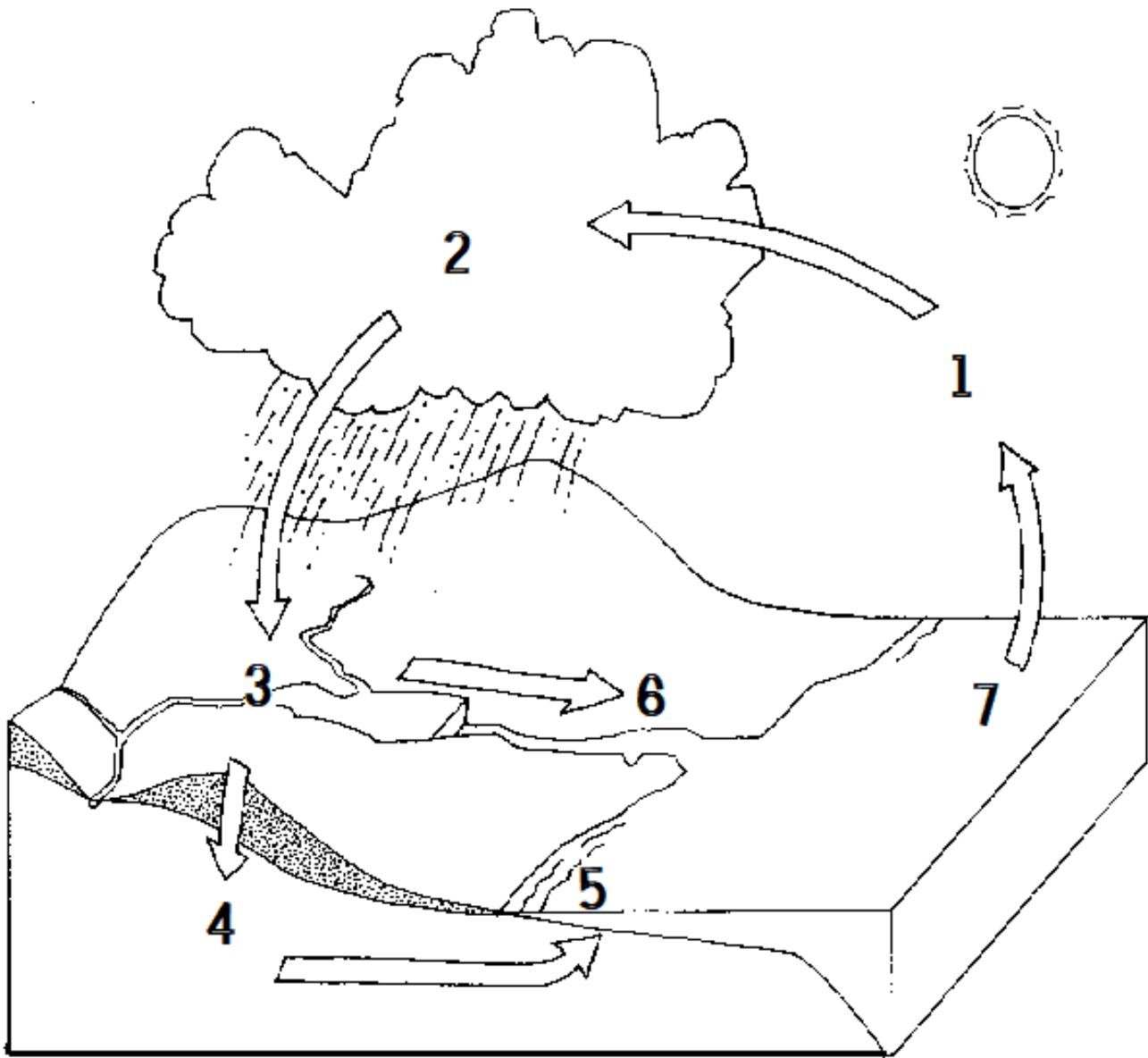


THE WATER CYCLE
