

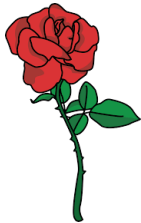
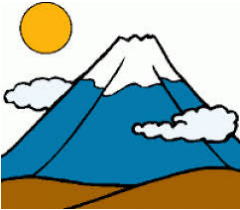

A long straight structure spanning a gap such as a river.	
The substances used to create or manufacture objects or structures (eg., rubber, steel, wood, etc.)	
The shape of an object or structure.	
A push or a pull that can cause movement, or change the speed or direction of motion of an object.	
A force which tries to pull two objects toward each other; the pull (attraction) of the earth on things at or near its surface which causes unsecured objects to fall.	
The purpose for which an object or structure exists.	
The ability of a structure to keep its balance and stay in place.	
The ability of a structure to resist a force. (eg, wind, load or gravity)	
Something built using various parts assembled in a particular way and designed for a specific purpose.
