The spaces between the cupcakes represent those that are eaten. Name the eaten and uneaten portion as a fraction.

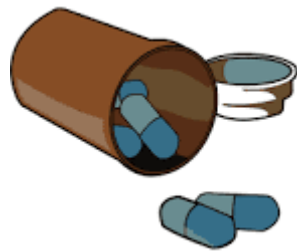

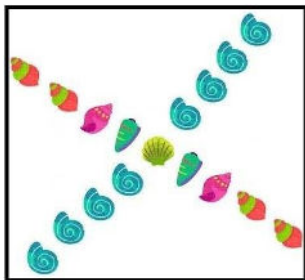

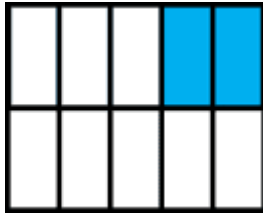

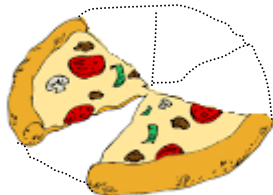

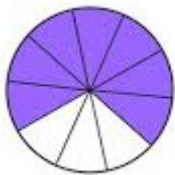
