For this one, you count on wards first to ten and ten to 14.

Example: $14 - 9 =$

$$\begin{array}{r} 14 \\ -9 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

make 10

$$9 + 1 = 10$$

$$10 + 4 = 14$$

$$1 + 4 = 5$$

Thus: $14 - 9 = 5$
