

ADDITION 1

When adding numbers line up the numbers on the right side. Then add the ones first.

Example 1: Tishanna is on page 42 in new book. Tomorrow she hopes to read 34 more pages. What page will she be on if she reads that many pages?

You find the “sum“, by adding the two numbers.

$$\begin{array}{r} + 42 \\ 34 \\ \hline 6 \end{array} \qquad \begin{array}{r} + 42 \\ 34 \\ \hline 76 \end{array}$$

Answer: Tishanna should be on page **76**.

Remember to regroup when necessary.

Exercise 2: Kia and Ken are making snowballs. They both made 19 snowballs. How many did they make altogether?

$$\begin{array}{r} 1 \\ + 19 \\ 19 \\ \hline 38 \end{array}$$

Answer: Kia and Ken made **38 snowballs**.
