When do you use **good** and **well**?

Use **good** as an adjective to modify nouns or pronouns.

Example:



This veggie wrap is **good**. [Note: **good** describes the noun.]

Use **well** to modify verbs. **Well** can also modify a noun when it refers to someone's health.



Lisa cooks **well**. [Note: "**well**" tells us how Lisa cooks.]



Aunt Betty is not feeling well today.
