$$\begin{array}{r} \$14 \\ + \$31 \\ \hline \$45 \end{array}$$

\$15.25 + \$50.70

\$24.20 + \$17.90

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#4. Solve one-step and two-step problems in currency using addition and subtraction.

Example: $\$25 + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = \$10 + \$34$

$$\begin{array}{r} \$10 \\ + \$34 \\ \hline \$44 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{r} \$34 \\ - \$25 \\ \hline \$19 \end{array}$$

Answer= $\$25 + \$\underline{19} = \$10 + \34
