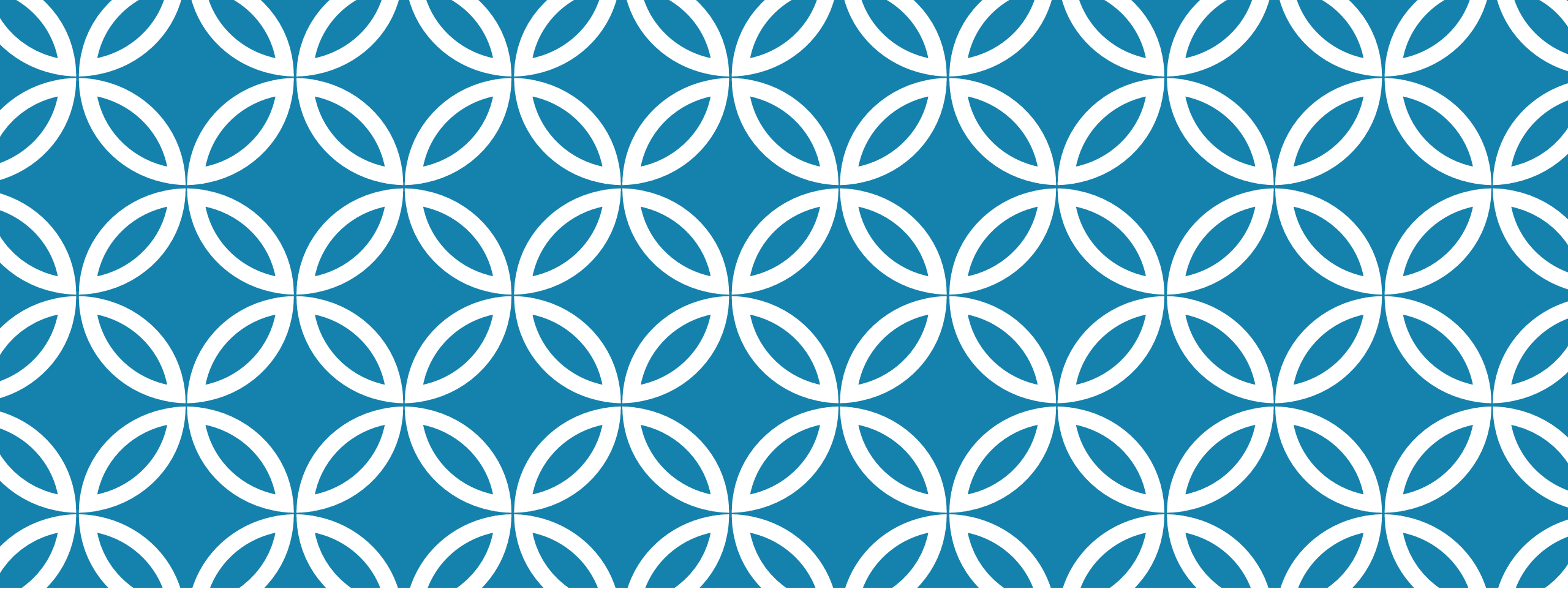

Greeting people.

HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Generally, you can greet people by saying:

Hola.

Note the “h” is silent, it is not pronounced.

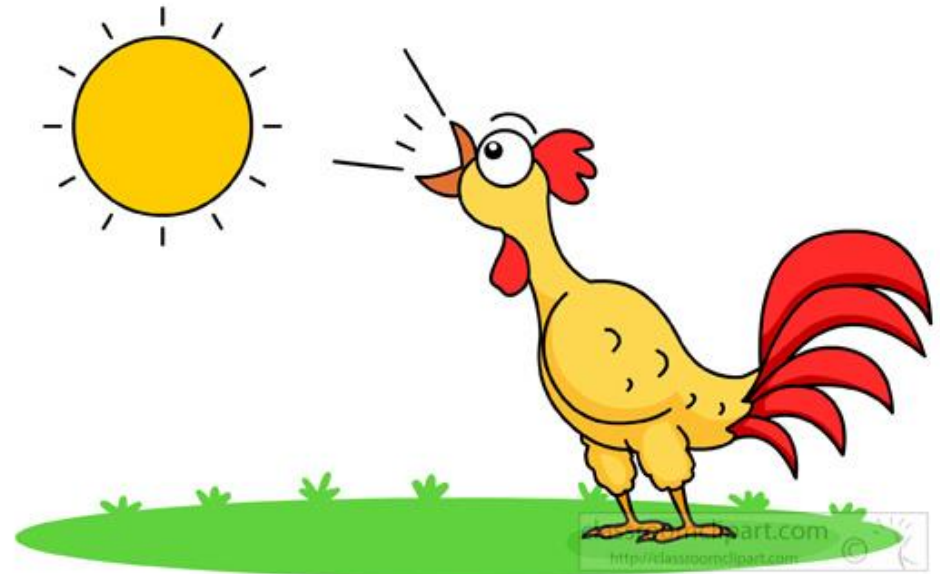


HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Depending on the time of day you can also say:

Buenos días .

Note: This literally means good day, but it is also used to say “Good morning”.

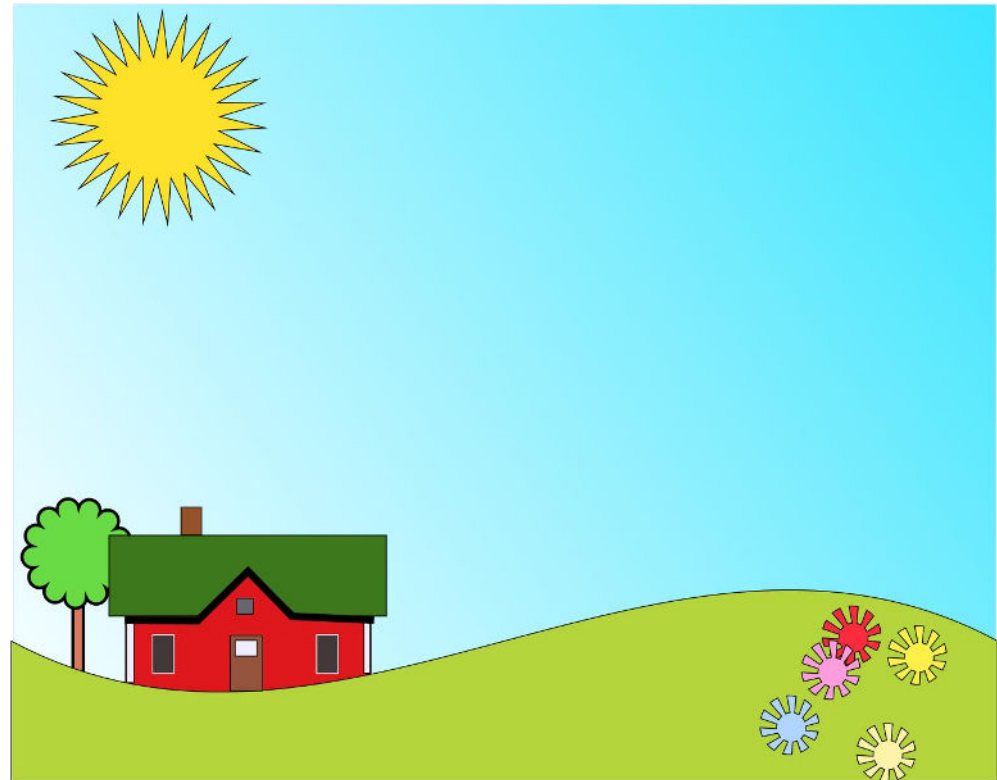


HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Next, depending on the time we can also say:

Buenas tardes.

Note: This means good afternoon or good evening, when you can still see sunlight outside.



Buenas noches.

HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Now, if it is dark we would then say:

Buenas noches.

Note: This means good night and it is used when you meet someone at night or when you are going to bed.

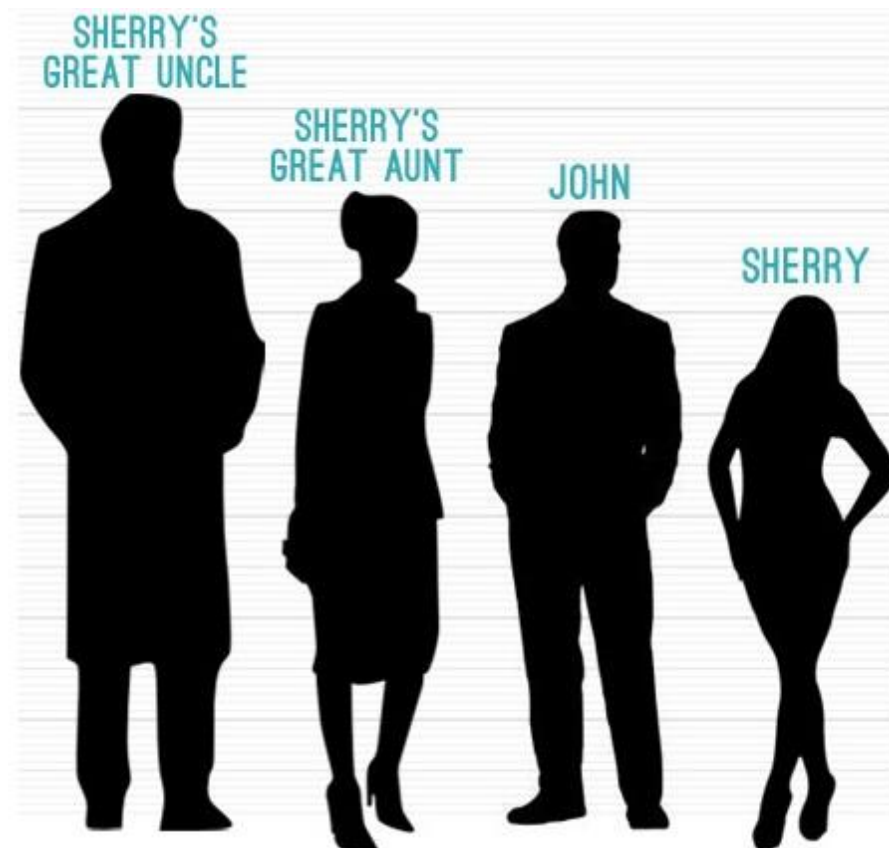


HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Remember, you may greet friend and older people. When you meet older people you need to be respectful and use the words:

**Señor/Señorita/
Señora**

Note: This means Mister/Miss/Mistress
(Mrs.)



HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Let's practice greeting people you may meet. Say hello to the man.

Hola, Señor.



HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

How would you greet this lady?

Hola, Señorita.

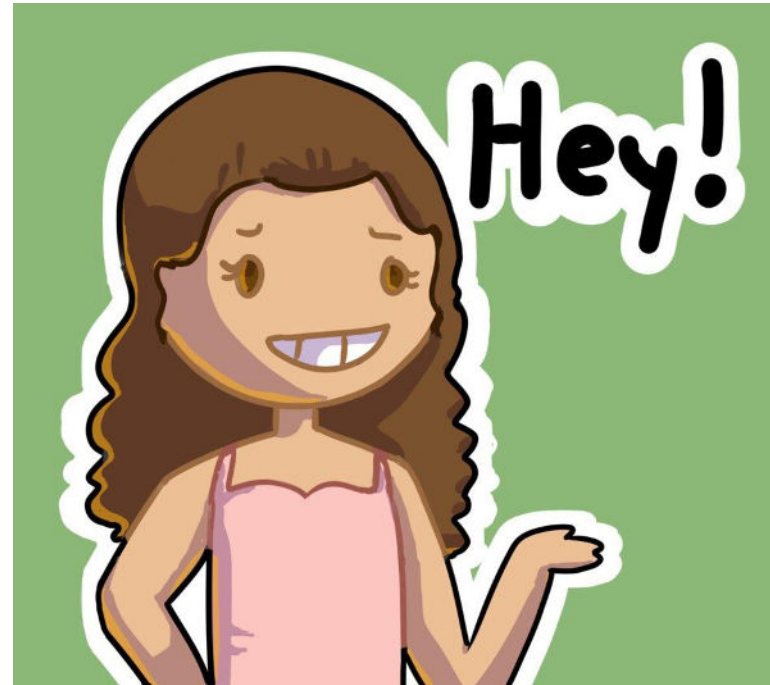


HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

How would you greet your friend?

Hola, amiga.

Note: “**Amiga**” means **friend** in Spanish. It is used for a female friend.



HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

How would you greet your friend?

Hola, amigo.

Note: “**Amigo**” means **friend** in Spanish. It is used for a male friend.



HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

How would you greet your teacher?

Hola, Profesor.

Note: “**Profesor**” means **teacher** in Spanish.



HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Now, let's greet Lucia as if you meet her in the evening.

**Buenas tardes,
Lucia.**

Note: This means "Good evening, Lucia".



HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Now, let's greet Mr. Castillo as if you meet him in the morning.

**Buenos días,
Señor Castillo.**

Note: This means “Good morning, Mr. Castillo”.

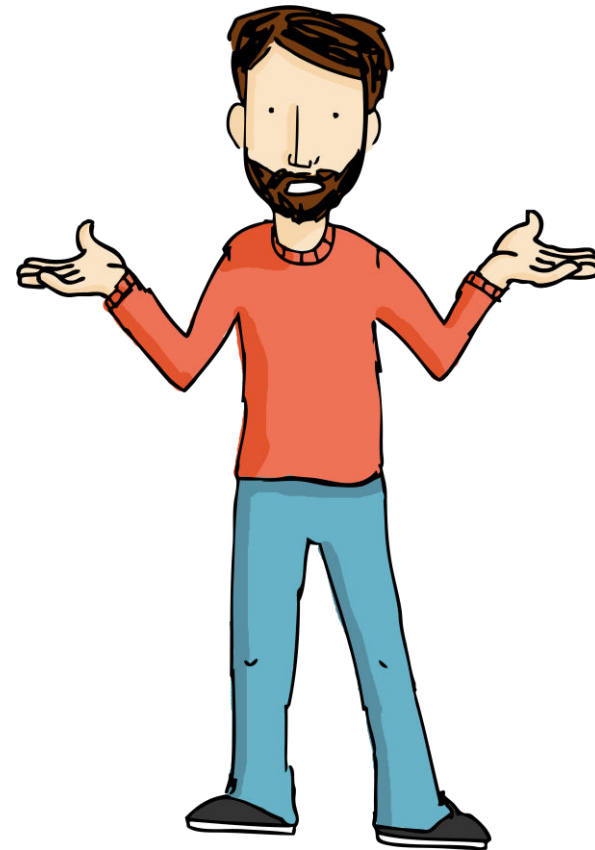


HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Now, let's tell Mr. Iglesia good night, as you are about to go to bed.

**Buenas noches,
Señor Iglesia.**

Note: This means "Good night, Mr. Iglesia."

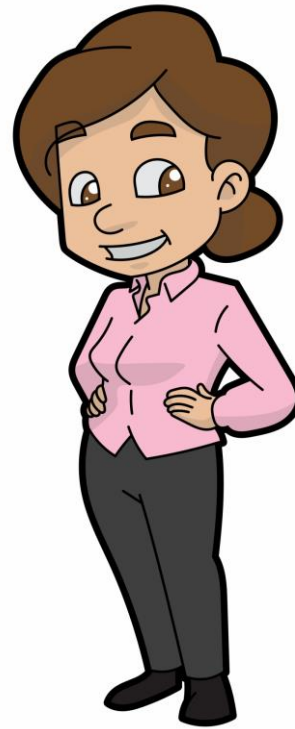


HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

Now, let's tell Mrs. Iglesia good evening,
as you now meet her in the park.

**Buenas tardes,
Señora Iglesia.**

Note: This means “Good evening,
Mrs. Iglesia”.



HOW TO GREET PEOPLE IN SPANISH

You are now meeting your Spanish teacher for a morning class. How do you greet him?

**Buenos días,
profesor.**

Note: This means “Good morning, Sir or teacher”.
