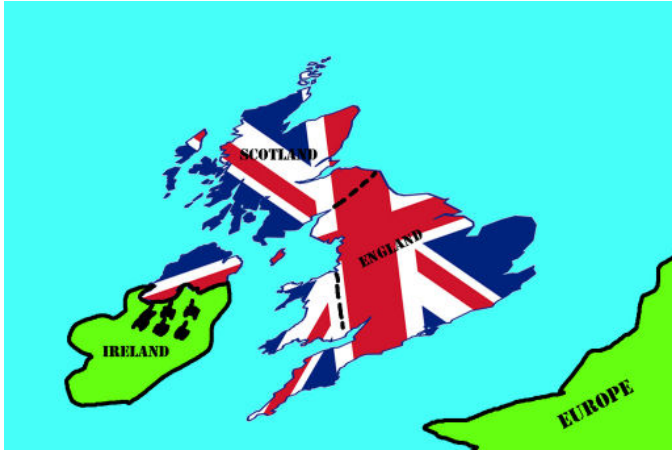

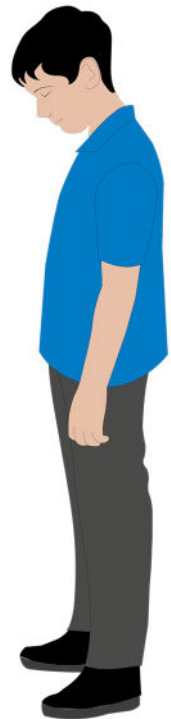
The Naughty Boy
