

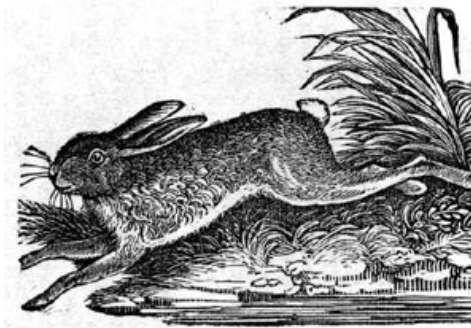

THE RABBIT

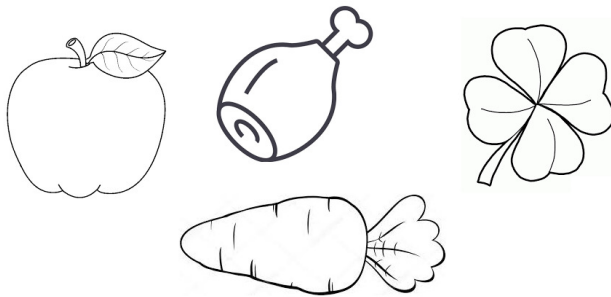
