

Activity: Respectful Role Play

Objective: To help children understand and practice respectful communication and behaviors in various relationship scenarios.

Materials Needed:

- Scenario cards (simple descriptions of different situations)
 - Props (optional, for added fun)
 - A space for role-playing

1. Discussion about respect and relationships.

What does respect mean?

Why is it important in friendships, family, and school?

2. Create Scenario Cards (15 minutes):

- Divide the children into small groups and ask them to come up with different scenarios where they can show respect. Examples include:

5. Wrap-Up (10 minutes):

- Write a reflection paragraph on what they learn about respectful communication in relationships.

Expected Outcomes:

- Children will learn to identify and practice respectful communication and behaviors.

- This activity promotes teamwork, creativity, and empathy among peers.
