3. Vincent is buying 2 loaves of bread, a large box of orange juice, 2 packs of sausage, and two container of ice cream. At the grocery, there are two lines, one for items less than 10, another for items more than 10. Which line should Vincent stand in? Explain your answer.
4. Mark has three bottles of marbles. One bottle has 10, another 6 and the third has 12. How much marbles does he have altogether?
5. A box of sweets cost \$6.90, a box of chocolate cost \$25.00, a pack of jelly beans cost \$9 and a box of cereal cost \$16.
 - a. How much does a box of cereal, sweets and chocolate cost?
 - b. If Joan has \$35. Which three items can she buy with the money?
