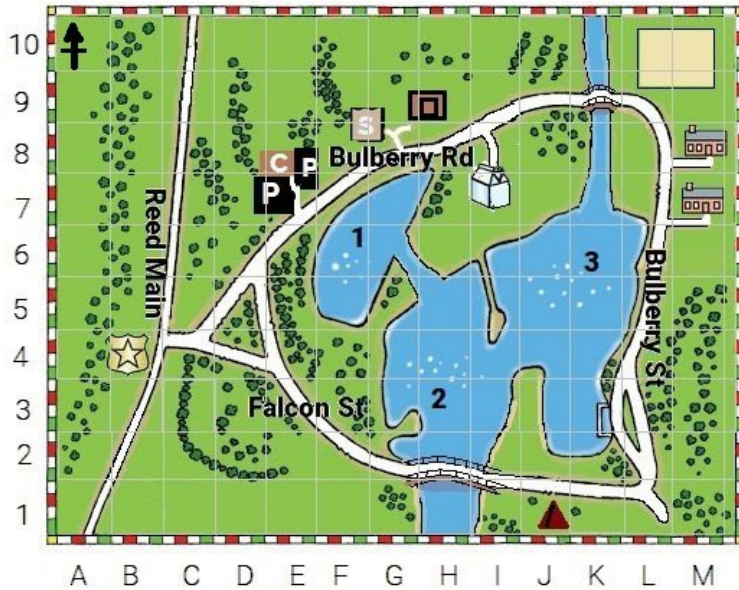


SCALE MAPS 1
